St. Vincent Indianapolis Hospital Cancer Program Community Outreach and Screening Services focus on reducing cancer rates by fostering wellness through education and outreach. We partner with businesses and other local, regional and statewide organizations to bring cancer education, prevention and screenings into the communities we serve. These partnerships enhance opportunities to reach large numbers of individuals and achieve the overall goal of reducing the incidence and mortality of cancer in Central Indiana.

As of November, free screenings through the St. Vincent Cancer Outreach program, in collaboration with WTHR 13, hosted 6 free screening events through Check-up 13, impacting 593 lives.

In addition, 530 free mammograms were provided through the St. Vincent Indianapolis Mobile Mammography Program to those individuals who were uninsured, underinsured or had high deductibles, impacting their ability to receive a screening mammogram.
