Step inside PACE marketing and intake

... where outreach and education bring new faces to PACE

Marketing and intake staff are the educators and matchmakers. We share stories about participants and staff to help PACE come alive. We want others to feel the difference PACE makes in the lives we serve. We attend community events, networking groups, health fairs and visit organizations.

We are the warm welcome inside PACE for callers and visitors. We explain PACE and give tours. Our staff starts the intake process to determine if someone is eligible and what our services might look like for them. If they are not a match, we provide ideas for other resources or services. If a match is made, we invite them to join PACE and complete the enrollment process.

PACE is an option for those "55 or better" who struggle to live independently. Struggles may be due to physical, memory or unstable health challenges. We support those living in community (house, apartment or living with another). PACE partners with existing support and assesses what is needed to keep someone safe and well. We do not provide placement services. Instead, it is our goal to keep participants in community and out of nursing homes.

As a PACE participant, family member or employee, reach out with stories (without names) and educate others. Many of our current participants learned about PACE just this way.
