The CoC is dedicated to improving survival and quality of life for cancer patients through standard-setting, prevention, research, education, and the monitoring of comprehensive quality care.

Both St. John Hospital and Medical Center and Providence Hospital underwent surveys for the American College of Surgeons CoC reaccreditation in November 2017. St. John Macomb-Oakland Hospital underwent their reaccreditation survey in May 2015. SJMOH received 3-year reaccreditation with commendation, silver ranking.

The SJP Community Health Assessment identified lung, breast, colorectal and prostate cancer as the disease sites most frequently diagnosed in SJP geographical area. The areas assessed were Metropolitan Detroit, Wayne, Macomb, Oakland, St. Clair, and Livingston Counties. The community outreach plan was to increase cancer awareness and help the community identify risk factors.

According to the National Cancer Institute prevention and screening represent the twin pillars of our preemptive defenses against cancer. Cancer prevention includes efforts to detect and treat precancerous conditions or cancers at their earliest, most treatable stages, and the prevention of new, or second primary cancers in survivors.

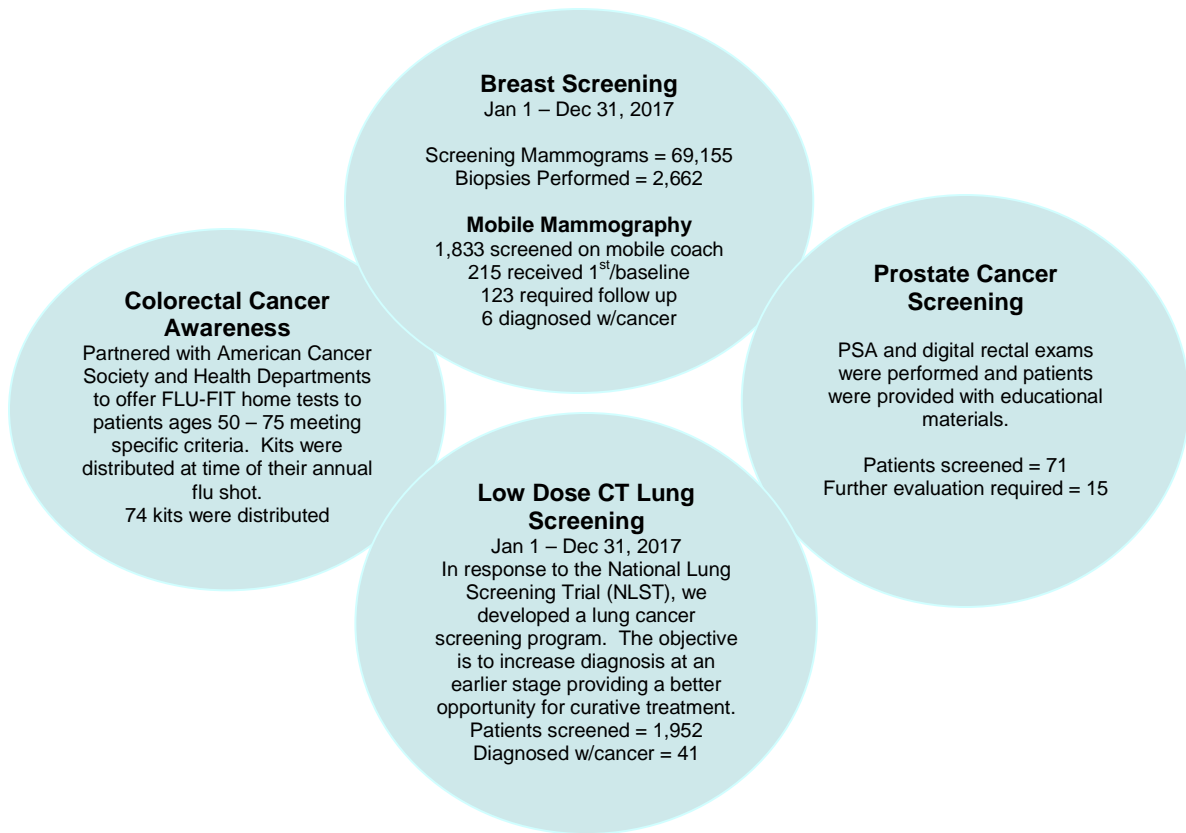

The mobile mammography program follows ACR guidelines and continues to grow and increase access of patients to breast health care. The mobile coach is equipped with a television so as patients wait for their mammogram, educational facts are playing on the TV. The information includes healthy lifestyle choices, the importance of cancer screenings, detection, and prevention. As the patient leaves the coach after their mammogram, they are provided with the following: How to perform a breast self-exam shower card, *How to prevent and Detect Cancer* booklet, and contact information for the mobile coach coordinator.

### Colorectal Screening - 2017

Partnered with the American Cancer Society and the Macomb and Wayne County Health Departments to offer the FLU-FIT home tests to patients ages 50 – 75 who have not had a colonoscopy within the past 10 years and/or have not completed a colorectal cancer screening test (FIT or FOBT) in the last year. The home tests were distributed at the time of their annual flu shots.
