Temporary visitor guidelines: COVID-19

Visitor limitations within all Ascension care settings are necessary for the safety of our patients, visitors, care teams and community to control the spread of Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

What visitors need to know before entering:

Dell Children's Inpatient Visitors

- No visitors under 12 years of age.
- **Non-COVID-19 patients:** Two (2) visitors at a time that may be rotated between four (4) people.
- **COVID positive patients:** One (1) visitor. Must stay for the duration of the hospitalization or until isolation is discontinued.
- All visitors will be required to complete a screening for entry including temperature checks.

Dell Children's ER (due to social distancing requirements in waiting rooms)

- One (1) visitor permitted per patient.

Dell Children's Surgery and Hospital Clinics

- Two (2) visitors permitted per patient.

What visitors need to do once cleared for entry:
