



Your child is scheduled for a specialized hearing evaluation called a non-sedated auditory brainstem response (ABR) at Dell Children's Medical Center. Please read and follow these important steps:

- Plan your travel so that you check in 15 minutes before your appointment time. This will allow time for registration. If you are more than 15 minutes late, your appointment will be rescheduled. Remember to bring your photo ID/DL and insurance cards to your appointment.**
- This procedure may take up to two and a half hours. Please plan for childcare/transportation accordingly.**
- Please DO NOT bring other children to this appointment. The presence of other children will disrupt testing and may require us to reschedule your appointment.**
- In order to obtain accurate results, the baby must be sleeping during the evaluation. Please make sure that the baby arrives ready to eat and sleepy. Some suggestions are provided below:**
 - **Delay feeding your baby for a few hours before the appointment. You will be allowed to feed him/her when you arrive, which will help him/her sleep during the test.**
 - **Keep your baby awake in the car on the way to the hospital. If possible, arrange for another adult to travel with you so you are able to keep the infant awake in the car.**

Need to cancel or reschedule the appointment?

If you need to cancel or reschedule the appointment, please call us at 512-324-9999 ext. 86349. We are able to reschedule the appointment; however, **if your child will reach 3 months of age before we are able to retest, the procedure will be done using sedation.**
