Our simulation scenarios cover a wide range of potential pediatric emergencies such as:

- Altered mental status
- Cardiac emergencies
- Chest tube insertion
- Child abuse
- Diabetic emergencies
- Drowning
- Drug ingestion
- End-of-life care
- Mass casualties
- Motor vehicle accidents
- Pneumothorax/pleurocentesis
- Respiratory distress/failure
- Seizures
- Shock
- Status asthmaticus
- Trauma/non-accidental trauma
