1. Have a hearing test. All you need is a written order from your doctor. If you've had a hearing test in the past 12 months, the audiologist will simply need to review it.
2. Have a hearing aid evaluation. Your audiologist will help you determine which hearing aid design, technology and features can improve your communication and quality of life.
3. Sixty-day trial period. Wear your new hearing aids everyday and experience the benefits of the latest technology in challenging listening situations.

What to expect

- Hearing aids range in size from completely in the ear canal to discreetly behind the ear.
- Hearing aids automatically adjust voices and sounds while minimizing background noise.
- Give yourself time to get accustomed to wearing hearing aids and listening in a new way.
- Everyone's hearing is unique. Our goal is to make your life sound better.

What to know

- Some hearing aids are now rechargeable and offer all day power on one charge.
- Download the app to access additional features and discreetly control your hearing aids.
- Direct connect to your smartphone for convenient hands-free calls.
- Stream music, podcasts and even GPS directions from your phone or tablet to your hearing aids.



Hearing checklist

If you or someone you know has one or more of the following symptoms, they may have a hearing loss:

- Asking people to repeat things
- Hearing people talking but not understanding the words
- Having trouble understanding people when there is background noise
- Misunderstanding names, phone numbers or directions
- Ringing in the ears
- Having trouble listening on the telephone
- Turning up the volume on the television or radio
- Feeling tired or stressed from concentrating during conversations
- Avoiding social situations because of hearing trouble
