Audiology pediatric services

Services for the evaluation and treatment of hearing disorders in children.

- At 3-6 months, does your child look to see where sounds come from; smile when spoken to; and like toys that make noise?
- At 12-18 months, does your child imitate new words, speak 10-20 words, and point to body parts?
- At 18-24 months, does your child use his/her own first name; use two-word sentences; and understand yes/no questions?
- At 3-4 years, does your child understand “why” questions, tell you about pictures in books or drawings?

First true words appear around 12-15 months of age

If you answered “no” to any of these questions, your child may need a hearing test.

Audiology

Early detection and intervention of hearing loss in infants and children. Diagnostic procedures include:

- Complete audiologic evaluation or hearing test
- Tympanometry — assesses middle ear function (fluid in the ear)
- Auditory brainstem response (ABR) — assesses hearing function in infants and toddlers while they are sleeping.
- Use of animated toys to assess hearing in toddlers 6-24 months.
- Use of conditioned play with blocks and picture-pointing tasks.
- Custom swim molds for children with tubes in their ears.

Newborn hearing screenings

- Evaluate your newborn’s hearing during the birth admission with OAE and ABR screening technology.
- Provide outpatient infant hearing screenings or rescreens as needed.

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
