### Weight Loss Surgery

#### Indications - Morbid obesity

- BMI > 35 with 1-2 comorbid conditions
- Diabetes/Hypertension/Sleep apnea
- BMI >40



## Weight Loss Surgery

#### Contraindications

- Certain medical conditions may preclude some weight loss operations ask your surgeon for specific illnesses., i.e. (Crohn's disease)
- Smokers
- Alcohol abuse
- Active malignancy



# **Expected Outcomes**

- Weight loss about 50% excess body weight
- Resolution or reduction in comorbid conditions (Diabetes/Hypertension/Sleep apnea)
- Decrease need for certain medications
- Extend life expectancy
- Improve quality of life



### **Expected Outcomes**

### Alternatives to surgery

- Diet
- Exercise
- Appetite suppressants



### **Expected Outcomes**

### **Activity / Diet**

- Pre-op
  - Increase activity
  - 1-2 week pre-op liquid diet
- Post-op
  - Slow progression of diet from ice chips  $\rightarrow$  clear liquids  $\rightarrow$  thick liquids  $\rightarrow$  soft  $\rightarrow$  regular diet
  - Increase activity goal 10,000 steps per day



### **Sleeve Gastrectomy**

- Pure restrictive procedure
- Simple/straight forward
- Most common weight loss surgery today
- Very well tolerated

Drawbacks	Contra-Indications	Risks
• may cause GERD	<ul> <li>severe reflux</li> <li>large hiatal hernias</li> <li>pre-malignant esophageal conditions</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>bleeding</li> <li>infection</li> <li>staple line leak</li> <li>blood clots</li> <li>death</li> </ul>



### **Gastric Bypass**

- Gold standard operation for weight loss
- Primary or secondary procedure
- Requires intestinal rerouting
- Best for sweet eaters
- Best for severe reflux

Drawbacks	Contra-Indications	Risks
<ul> <li>long term risk of internal hernia</li> <li>marginal ulcer</li> </ul>	• certain inflammatory bowel diseases	<ul> <li>bleeding</li> <li>infection</li> <li>bowel injury</li> <li>staple line leak</li> <li>blood clots</li> <li>vitamin deficiency</li> <li>death</li> </ul>



### **Duodenal Switch**

- Malabsorptive
- Possible primary or secondary procedure

Drawbacks	Contra-Indications	Risks
<ul> <li>vitamin/protein deficiency</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>certain inflammatory bowel diseases</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>bleeding</li> <li>infection</li> <li>staple line leak</li> <li>blood clots</li> <li>vitamin/protein deficiency</li> <li>death</li> </ul>



### Lap Band

Pure restrictive procedure

Drawbacks	Contra-Indications	Risks	
<ul> <li>unpredictable weight loss</li> <li>frequent appointments for lap band fills</li> </ul>	• large hiatal hernias	<ul> <li>bleeding</li> <li>infection</li> <li>band slippage</li> <li>port malposition</li> <li>death</li> </ul>	



### **Orbera® Balloon**

Restrictive procedure

Non-surgical

Drawbacks	Contra-Indications	Risks
• <u>No</u> insurance coverage	<ul> <li>previous stomach surgery</li> <li>large hiatal hernia</li> <li>ulcer disease</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>balloon perforation</li> <li>pancreatic inflammation</li> <li>balloon migration</li> <li>early removal</li> <li>GERD</li> <li>nausea/vomiting</li> </ul>



# **Required Mineral Supplements**

- Multivitamin
- B-Complex
- Vitamin D as needed
- Calcium citrate 1800/mg/day
- Elemental or chelated iron as needed





#### Not recommended for 1-2 years after surgery

### ...as soon as possible if:

- Temperature is >101 degrees
- Nausea/Vomiting
- Shortness of breath
- Rapid heart rate
- Abdominal pain
