Welcome to the Ascension St. John Transplant Center

Our care team is here to guide you through the evaluation process of kidney transplantation. We are dedicated to treating you like family and answering any questions you may have.

Pre-transplant evaluation checklist

To start the pre-transplant evaluation process, you will need to schedule the general health tests listed below with your primary care physician. Please send the results to your transplant coordinator prior to your pre-transplant evaluation at our center.

General health testing:

- Dental evaluation by your regular dentist
- PAP smear for all females who meet criteria
- Mammogram for females age 35 or older
- Colonoscopy for all patients age 50 or older
- Current medication list
- Copy of history/physical from your nephrologist
- TB skin test
- Hepatitis B vaccine

Evaluation appointment

It is very important that you and your support person attend your first evaluation appointment. If you need to cancel or reschedule your appointment, please notify our team at least one week in advance.

During this appointment, you will meet with the following members of our multidisciplinary team:

- Transplant nephrologist
- Transplant social worker
- Transplant dietitian
- Transplant pharmacist
- Transplant financial coordinator
- Transplant coordinator
- Education and informed consent
- Lab for kidney recipient profile

Your coordinator will also order the following tests:

- CT scan of chest, abdomen and pelvis
- Echocardiogram
- Stress test with cardiology consult
- Carotid Doppler scan

Evaluation appointment review process

Once the required evaluation and testing is completed, our team will review your evaluation results and will discuss with you if you are eligible for transplantation at our center.

Once all testing is complete and your health maintenance items are received, you will be presented to our patient selection committee for approval or denial of listing on the UNOS waitlist. Once you are on the transplant list, you have the option of waiting for a deceased donor or you can choose the living donor option. If you have a friend or family member who is willing to donate a kidney to you, they can call our living donor coordinator at **918-744-2925**.
