



## Ascension Rx Medication Assistance Program

Ascension Rx Medication Assistance Program assists low income, uninsured patients with their medication needs through the use of donated medications (FREE) and medications on its Safety List (\$3 or \$10 copay). Patients receiving Medicare (enrolled or eligible) or VA benefits are excluded. TennCare recipients are accepted, but must utilize TennCare benefits first. TennCare beneficiaries are only eligible to receive medications on the Safety Net List.

### **\*\*\*ATTENTION\*\*\***

The following items are **REQUIRED** in order to receive services:

**1. Complete Program Application**

Applications are available in the pharmacy or online at the pharmacy's Google Business Profile

**2. Current Photo Identification**

Types Accepted: Driver's License or State ID card, Passport, or photo ID from originating country

**3. Proof of Income**

Types Accepted: Current Tax Return, month of paycheck stubs, unemployment checks, statement from Social Security office for SS, SSDI or SSI, AFDC, PENSIONS, or Food Stamp approval letter

- Once enrolled, patients must notify staff of any changes in employment, income, or insurance status prior to having additional prescriptions filled
- Controlled substances, cold/allergy meds, and other OTC products are **NOT COVERED**
- Donated medications are **FREE**
- Safety Net medications are **\$3.00** (most prescriptions) or **\$10** (smoking cessation patches, Albuterol HFA inhaler, blood pressure monitor, and a few other select medications).
